

New Haven Community Schools

The Board of Education for New Haven Community Schools is in search of a new superintendent. This is only the preliminary posting; the selection criteria for the ideal candidate will be added at a later date. We encourage interested applicants to refrain from applying until the selection criteria is posted.

Location – The Village of New Haven is located in northern Macomb County along the I-94 corridor and 26 Mile Road. New Haven is close to shopping, entertainment and other specialties a few miles south in Chesterfield Township and Sterling Heights. The village has a population 4752 and covers 2.53 mi².

District – New Haven Community Schools has seen an enrollment increase. The district serves New Haven, Lenox, Chesterfield, and Ray Township and covers 55 mi². In 2019, the residents supported a \$25 million dollar bond proposal. The bond is being used to update safety and security, technology, transportation, and instructional environments.
