

The Board of Education for Yale Public Schools is in search of a new superintendent.

Yale Public Schools is a rural district with a small town feel. The 150 square mile District is nestled in the Northwest Corner of St. Clair County which is a mere stone's throw away from the beautiful Blue Water Area and the shorelines of Lake Huron.

Yale Public Schools is comprised of three Elementary Buildings, a Junior High, and a High School. Our District boasts four Reward Schools as identified by the Michigan Department of Education and also a National Blue Ribbon School as identified by the U.S. Department of Education last year. The District offers early childhood programming through Great Start as well as Pre-School programming in each of our Children's Centers.
