The Board of Education for Onaway Area Schools is in search of a new superintendent.

Onaway Area Schools hosts grades PK-12 in a 120,000 sq. ft. building located on 90 acres. Our beautiful building and grounds are maintained by an excellent custodial team. We have an exceptional staff, many of whom are alumni, and more than half of our teaching staff possess a master's degree. With a pupil count of 559, our teacher-to-student ratio is 1:17. We also partner with the Presque Isle County Sheriff Department to have an SRO on campus. Our Cardinal Beginnings Daycare, located in a separate building on campus, offers early education and child care starting at age 2½.

As part of the COPESD, we are able to offer speech therapy, occupational therapy, social work and other educational supports. A large number of our high school students benefit from our partnership with local D colleges to take dual enrollment courses. We also offer our high school students online courses through a collaboration with Michigan Virtual. In addition to academics, we also have a very competitive athletic department and offer our students other extracurriculars such as robotics and band. Our students rank in the top tier in the area for standardized testing scores. *U.S. News & World Report* listed our elementary as one of best elementary schools for 2022.
