Oscoda County offers a relaxed atmosphere with abundant hunting and fishing opportunities and outdoor recreational activities. Approximately 78% of our students come from economically disadvantaged households and the county's median household income is \$42,335.00. The demographic is predominately Caucasian, and the political background is conservative. The district is comprised of three small villages and the countryside between them. Those villages are Comins, Curran, and Fairview. These communities have been very supportive of the educational process. All Kindergarten through 12th-grade students and administrative staff are housed in one building.
