

Haslett Public Schools

The Board of Education for Haslett Public Schools is in search of a new superintendent.

Haslett is located just east of Michigan's capital city of Lansing. It is ten minutes from the main campus of Michigan State University, home of the Spartans. Most of the community's residents are professionally employed by MSU, Lansing Community College, the Michigan State Government, General Motors, and at area public schools. The district has nearly 2,600 students and employs 173 teachers. The main traveling corridors of I-69, US 127, and I-96 are accessible within minutes of the community.

The district completed a \$33 million bond in 2021 updating instructional areas, athletic facilities, security systems, and instructional technology. New math (Reveal Math) and reading (Into-Reading) curriculums have been implemented K-8. Haslett Public Schools strives to provide an A+ learning community that promotes excellence for all students.
