It is a one-room school district located in Newaygo County, north of Baldwin and west of Big Rapids, and is a constituent district of the Newaygo County Regional Educational Service Agency. Big Jackson was founded in 1894 and in many ways has remained unchanged since. The district offers a unique education where students thrive given the favorable staff to student ratio, and values and civic expectations are a significant part of the learning experience.

Big Jackson is an out-of-formula district with a healthy fund balance however the district is facing some significant challenges. Among those challenges, the buildings are currently not suitable for occupancy so consequently many students are currently attending another local district and others are receiving instruction online. The primary goal of the Board of Education is for the district to become fully operational and offering in-person instruction at the beginning of the 2025-2026 school year.

Another major challenge; the district does not currently have a process in place to manage the budget or process payroll. Current administration is working to engage an outside party to perform financial duties.

This is a tremendous opportunity for the right person to use their professional expertise and creativity to build a school district from the ground up.
