The Woodhaven-Brownstown Board of Education is seeking a Superintendent to begin work on July 1, 2026. The Board is assisted in the search by the Michigan Association of School Boards (MASB).

Woodhaven-Brownstown is located in southern Wayne County, Michigan. The community offers a warm, engaging atmosphere that attracts residents and visitors alike. The School District serves 5411 students with a budget of \$76,760,000. The District recently created a Strategic Plan for 2024-26 which includes goals of LEARNING including cultivating academic excellence, offering programs beyond the core, and developing resilient, empathetic and well-rounded individuals; Creating safe and secure EDUCATIONAL ENVIRONMENTS including expanding state of the art facilities that are accessible, flexible, and inclusive; and EMPLOYEE DEVELOPMENT AND WELL-BEING including employee growth, recruiting, hiring, and retaining top talent, providing high quality professional development, and growing a supportive, positive, and caring workforce.
